## Announcement on review of financial statements / accounting records

## PRESS RELEASE

Half year 2003 financial figures of ELLINIKI TECHNODOMIKI TEB SA and AKTOR SA TECHNICAL COMPANY.

The 2003 half year financial figures of the ELLINIKI TECHNODOMIKI TEB - AKTOR SA Group appear increased compared to the respective 2002 period.

According to the respective accounting records, financial results appear as follows:

ELLINIKI TECHNODOMIKI TEB's consolidated profit before tax rose to  $\notin$  69.91 million, compared to  $\notin$  56.31 million in the f<sup>t</sup> half of 2002, increased by 24.15%, and, to  $\notin$  51.71 million after subtracting minority interest, compared to  $\notin$  40.81 million in the respective period of 2002, increased by 26.72%. The consolidated turnover rose to  $\notin$  461.99 million, compared to  $\notin$  **2**9.69 million in the fist half of 2002, increased by 40.13%.

As regards ELLINIKI TECHNODOMIKI TEB's pre-consolidated figures, these were as follows: the consolidated turnover amounted to  $\notin 6.29$  million, compared to  $\notin 2.94$  million, an increase of 113.67%, and profit before tax to  $\notin 37.25$  million, compared to  $\notin 9.78$  million, an increase of 281%.

AKTOR's consolidated turnover rose to  $\notin$  459.69 millon, profit before tax to  $\notin$  64.83 million, and, after subtracting minority interest, profit amounted to  $\notin$  64.39 million.

AKTOR's turnover amounted to  $\notin$  422.04 million, compared to  $\notin$  326.70 million in the first half of 2002, an increase of 29.18%. The company's profit before tax amounted to  $\notin$  61.88 million, compared to  $\notin$  55.10 million last year, an increase of 12.30%.

As regards REDS SA (former A. KAMBAS SA), the company's turnover rose to  $\notin$  9.25 million. The company also showed a profit of  $\notin$ 621.90 thousand in the first half of the year, compared to a loss of  $\notin$  86.02 thousand in the respective 2002 period. The company's consolidated turnover rose to  $\notin$  2.11 million, compared to  $\notin$  643.36 thousand in the first half of 2002, whereas the consolidated result was negative, showing a consolidated loss of  $\notin$  894.96 thousand, before tax, for the 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2003, compared to a loss of  $\notin$  1,081.19 thousand in the respective 2002 period, and  $\notin$  815.55 million after subtracting minority interest, compared to a loss of  $\notin$  928.33 thousand.
